## Page 2, Rabbi's Article

As the weather gets colder and colder, and the days get shorter and shorter, we start to await the arrival of a much beloved holiday, Hanukah. When we light the Menorah we begin with one candle on the first night, progressively adding another one each night until the eighth night, when the candelabrum is fully lit. This way of lighting follows the opinion of Hillel, one of the great Rabbis of the second Temple period whose teachings were preserved in the Talmud. He taught us that we should always strive to increase light and holiness in our lives.

Our congregation gives us many opportunities to bring the warmth and light of Judaism into our lives. Of course, we have our regular Friday night and Shabbat morning services, followed by scrumptious collations provided by our caterer Adam. It is delightful to see many of us lingering after services while engaging in animated conversations, sharing both food and spiritual nourishment and enjoying our Synagogue as an important hub for social and religious connection. We also have our ongoing adult education program, our Friday Night lectures, our re-started Hebrew High and our Sunday morning Minyan shared with our Hebrew School, our Book Club and our Sisterhood's activities.

But, as it has been said, "it takes a village" to nurture a traditional Jewish lifestyle. Our neighborhood used to be a vibrant Jewish neighborhood years ago, with many Kosher restaurants, butchers, bakeries, etc. Now only the synagogues remain, and just a few Kosher outlets are still open. We need to support them, to insure that our neighborhood remains a place where it is possible to observe our dietary laws. Of course our local Kosher deli, Jay and Lloyd's, has a longtime tradition of supporting our Temple. Now the reopened Kosher pizza store, "Pizza by the Bay" is available as well and generously donates the pizza for our Temple's Hebrew High sessions. Please look them up in the Scribe's back cover (together with our other advertisers) and next time you eat out or order in give them your business. And while you are at it, thank them for supporting our Temple and say to them: Rabbi Kupchik sent me!

Please also don't forget to contribute to our fall-winter food drive, to benefit City Harvest, bringing nonperishable, unexpired food items to the boxes at the entrance of our office.




