Rabbi's Article

It is hard to believe that summer is over and the High Holidays are almost here. So much has happened in the last few months here at Temple Beth El that I would like to share with you.

We are now in the 21st century! We have a website: www.TempleBethElMB.org Please visit our website, which is a work in progress, to find out more about our congregation, our activities, the Shabbat Torah portion and candlelighting time and much more. Please do share with us any ideas or suggestions in order to improve it. We thank all who have already visited it and given us their input.

Attendance to our lively services continues to increase, and we still have the pleasure to enjoy enhanced Kiddushim after services that invite people to linger and enjoy the company of friends. Please come and join us if you have not been to our regular services lately. I am confident that you will be very pleasantly surprised and, of course, welcomed very warmly.

We face a serious challenge, and we need your help in dealing with it. The demographic nature of our neighborhood is changing, and because of that we have very few young families moving into the area.
